## **Financial Expectations for Recreational Dance Season**

- Registration Fee (\$35 per student) Includes one chaperone ticket per dancer for recital.
- Costume Fee (Est. \$75 per dancer per class)
- Monthly Tuition (\*See breakdown below)
- Recital Class Pictures (Similar to school or sports pics). Various packages available.
- Recital Tickets (est. \$12-\$15 per ticket)

<sup>\*</sup> Tuition is 10 equal payments, based on all classes averaged out over the season.

\*\*Unlimited Base Rate per family. \$245 will be your base rate for the whole family up to the 7-hour mark. Once 8 hours has been reached, there will be an additional \$75 for each student. Example: Two dancers taking a total of 7 hours a week is \$245 a month. Two dancers taking a total of 9 hours a week will be \$245 (unlimited base rate) plus \$75 for an additional child, equaling \$320 a month. Three dancers taking a total of 11 hours a week would be \$245 (unlimited base rate) plus \$150 for an additional 2 children, equaling \$395 a month.

#### Tuition is **NON-REFUNDABLE**

We require at least 20 days' notice of a dancer dropping a class. All accounts will be charged up to the 20<sup>th</sup> day after you notify the studio in writing (email preferred), not the last class attended.

### **Auto-Pay**

Signing up for auto pay is easy using your dancers' DSP portal. Please let us if you need help. All auto payments will be deducted on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, or the first weekday following the 1<sup>st</sup>. Auto withdraw will include total account balance. This may include any fees incurred after the previous month's draft. Costumes fees will be posted in October and withdrawn on November 1<sup>st</sup>.
