



Occupational First Aid Level 3 Training

COURSE OUTLINE

The WorkSafeBC Occupational First Aid Level 3 course is designed for remote worksites or employers located more than 20 minutes surface travel time from medical aid.

PREREQUISITES

A person must be at least 16 years old and have the physical ability to perform first aid skills required to complete the learning tasks.

CERTIFICATION

Certification for the OFA level 3 course requires full participation and course attendance. Candidates must demonstrate practical skill competency and achieve 70% on a multiple choice exam. Upon successful completion, the participant will receive a certification that is valid for three (3) years.

COURSE LENGTH

The duration of the Occupational First Aid level 3 course is 70 hours over 10 classroom days. Monday – Friday 8:30 am – 4:30 pm

COURSE CONTENT

- Basic life support (CPR-A)
- Patient assessment
- Critical airway and respiratory, interventions with C-Spine management, including insertion of oral airways, use of oxygen therapy equipment and bag valve mask
- Circulatory interventions and management
- Small wound, soft tissue, and fracture management
- Suction

Certification:

Successful participants must achieve 70% on both a written (multiple choice) & practical exam. Certification is valid for 3 years.

The tuition includes student manual, workbook, and exams. The course fee's vary depending on the location of the training. Please contact us regarding all course information including course schedule and fee's.
