Cook off Rules

1. Entry form and Fee must be summated to Melfort Ag Society (MAS) by July 15/2019 5:00 pm unless other written arrangements have been made
2. Teams will be a MAX of 2 people
3. Each team must prepare 1 entrée and 1 side to qualify for judging. The cost for this will be \$35. This includes 2 – one day passes.
4. Additional dishes may be purchased at a reduced rate of \$15 for entrées \$5 for sides and \$10 for desserts.
Example: If a team prepares 2 entrées and 2 sides the costs would be as follows: First entrée and first side \$35. Second entrée \$15 second side \$5. Total cost \$55.
5. Meats must be purchased or processed by a certified meat shop or butcher.
6. Meat cuts must be at a minimum size of 3lbs. Ribs must be a full rack. Chickens must be whole.
7. All entries **MUST** be prepared on site.
8. MAS will **NOT** have any Food storage or a Kitchen site available
9. Fire, Gas and Electric cooking will be acceptable
10. A limited number of 110V power is available on a 1st come 1st serve basis
11. Use of a personal generator is not permitted
12. Teams will need to supply their own power cord to hook into MAS power
13. Fires must be contained to a Fire Box **NO HOLES OR DUG IN PITS** will be permitted
14. Each team will have a head Cook who is responsible for team behavior, team area, food preparation and clean up
15. Each team will supply **ALL** cooking supplies needed for competition
16. There will be a mandatory meeting with the head cooks on Saturday July 20 at 10 AM at the Ag Society Office
17. **ALL DECISIONS MADE BY MAS ARE FINAL**
18. Cash prizes will be paid out
19. Turn in time will be 7:30 pm (Saturday)
20. Dessert judging will follow the main dishes
21. MAS reserves the right to dismiss any competitor with JUST cause
22. MAS will supply judging containers, entries not submitted in a judging container will be disqualified
23. MAS will have an official time keeper
24. Cooking internal temperatures must reach a minimum
 - Beef 145 °F
 - Chicken 180 °F
 - Pork 160 °F

25. Teams will be responsible for the leftover portions of their cooking. If teams choose to disperse their food for donations the MAS asks that the donations be submitted to develop the Cook Off program.
