- 16 proposed Wind Turbines in Sheboygan County
 - 673 feet tall - tallest in WI, taller than the US Bank building
 - Seeking a 99.2 Megawatt project with 16 turbines, but may expand to 24 turbines with 150 MW capacity
 - A project under 100 MW, means local control, but local ordinances can not be stricter than the Public Service Commission regulations (PSC 128).

 - Millions of wildlife deaths (bald eagles, bats, other birds) caused every year.
 - The amount of fossil fuels needed to build and maintain these turbines, rarely equates to the turbine paying for itself.
 - Short lifespan of 20-25 years, most are not removed or recycled after being decommissioned or they stop working.
