Biometric Appointment

Attend a biometric appointment to provide your fingerprints and a photograph for identification purposes.





Embassy fees and Immigration Health Surcharge

1 Visa Application Fee

Be prepared to pay the required visa application fee, which varies depending on the type of visa you are applying for.

2 Immigration Health Surcharge

Most foreign nationals applying for temporary permission to live in the UK are required to pay an **immigration health surcharge** (IHS) in addition to the visa application fee.

3 Payment Methods

Familiarize yourself with the accepted payment methods and plan accordingly to ensure a smooth visa application process.



Biometric and Interview if Required



Biometric Appointment

Attend the scheduled biometric appointment to provide your fingerprints and photograph for identification purposes.



Visa Interview

If required, be prepared to attend a visa interview at the embassy, where you may be asked questions about your studies and plans.





Visa Approval

Finally after a successful waiting time period You will receive your Visa stamped on your Passport in your hands.
