 - Administration report, Gabe:

 - President's report
 - Teacher/WEB prize request asked for feedback from WEB on what students would like
 - Conferences/food went well thanks to businesses and individuals
 - Night custodian, Jimmy, who puts up banners for us, was in the hospital for an extended period, won't be back to work for a while. Teachers doing a meal train. Kelsey moved to approve \$100 for meals and/or needs. Tari seconded. Approved.
 - Kelsey will share meal train sign up
 - Should have a discussion about setting a precedent for how we handle this in the future
 - Pilot Butte parent reached out, starting a new parent group, asking for support around grants. Kelsey will be sharing info

with them and invite them to attend a board meeting with a Q&A afterwards.

• Vice president's report

- Grant requests gave overview of teacher grant program. This year have a budget of \$10k.
 - Chess sets for Mountain Time secured from Leapin'
 Lizards rather than using grant funds
 - Foods parent asked if she could buy thrift store blenders to donate
- Scoreboard campaign gave overview of scoreboard needs in football field and gym
 - Raffle kicking off with Play It Again Sports, tickets for sale, prize is a \$250 gift card
 - Kendall Cares writing a grant request
- Concessions will be selling at home games, funds go to athletics
 - Les Schwab community outreach opportunity, Desiree been in touch, launching in December, will have more info in January, may be providing water and popcorn to subsidize our expenses
- Bottle Drop blue bags and tags if families would like to donate that money to the school, will go to general fund this year

• Treasurer's report

- Budget will be sharing at upcoming meeting
- Revenue giving campaign at just over \$23k, scoreboard \$1,900, apparel sales \$570, concessions \$645
- Expenses teacher grants allocated \$10k, spent \$445, admin grants \$5k allocated, spent \$3,524; fundraising spent \$1,300 on concession supplies, banners, printing, mailing; staff appreciation and graduation will be larger expenses later in the year

Secretary's report

- Would like to do an annual report highlighting grants awarded during the year
- Fundraising report

- Giving campaign coming to a close, shifting focus and putting on our "booster hat" to support scoreboard campaign/athletics, will also be pursuing other things like dine out fundraisers
 - MOD raised just under \$500, there is a "hunger" for more
 - Mountain Burger January 29
 - Will also be working on more dine out nights
- Discussed Highland fundraising successes, lots of ideas, like a coin race that raised \$1,500 in one week. Perhaps launch something after winter break and before staff appreciation week. But be mindful of asking too much.

 - b. Can put people on the reader board
 - c. Can create different tiers
