- **Protection for Travelers:** Guards those who journey physically or spiritually, ensuring safe passage.
- **Grounded Stability:** Anchors scattered or drifting energy back into alignment.

Spellwork Applications

- **Sealing Spells:** Used to close energetic wounds, finalize workings, or reinforce wards.
- **Binding Rites:** Added to jars, knots, or bundles to secure intentions or contain harmful forces.
- **Travel Charms:** Carried for protection during journeys, both mundane and mystical.
- **Stability Workings:** Incorporated into spells requiring grounding, structure, or long-term endurance.
- **Home Protection:** Placed near thresholds to keep the household's energy steady and safe.
