Magical Properties

- **Grounding:** Roots scattered energy, stabilizes the emotional body, and anchors intention.
- **Attraction:** Draws love, wealth, opportunity, and desired outcomes toward the practitioner.
- **Shadow-Wealth:** Enhances prosperity magic tied to earth, secrecy, and long-term gain.
- **Sensual Enchantment:** Awakens allure, confidence, and magnetic presence.

Spellwork Applications

- **Prosperity Charms:** Added to money jars, pouches, or altars to attract steady abundance.
- **Love & Desire Work:** Used in oils, incense, or sachets to enhance sensuality and draw affection.
- **Grounding Rites:** Burned or carried to stabilize the spirit before deep ritual or divination.
- **Manifestation Magic:** Incorporated into spells that require strong, rooted intention.
- **Shadow-Work:** Used to explore hidden desires, subconscious patterns, or buried emotional truths.

Notes for the Practitioner

Patchouli is a herb of deep earth. It does not flutter; it settles. It does not beckon loudly; it pulls with quiet certainty. Call upon it when your magic requires gravity, when your desires must take root, or when your spirit needs anchoring before stepping into deeper work. Treat it as a companion of soil and shadow — rich, steady, and irresistibly magnetic.
