- **Clarity Rites:** Burned or carried to reveal hidden motives, subtle influences, or spiritual interference.
- **Banishing Work:** Incorporated into spells that require firm removal of unwanted energies or entities.
- **Boundary Magic:** Added to workings that reinforce emotional, spiritual, or physical limits.

Rue is a herb of bitter guardianship. It does not whisper; it warns. It does not yield; it stands. Call upon it when your path feels tangled, when your spirit requires firm protection, or when your magic must cut through deception and subtle harm.
