## Spellwork Applications

- **Cleansing Rites:** Burned or symbolically used to clear rooms, altars, or ritual circles.
- **Tool Purification:** Placed with divination implements to maintain clarity and neutrality.
- **Threshold Magic:** Used at doorways or liminal points to guard and sanctify.
- **Emotional Clearing:** Added to blends that dissolve tension, fear, or lingering emotional residue.
- **Spirit-Work Preparation:** Employed before trance, scrying, or communication with subtle presences.

Call upon it when your space feels clouded, when your spirit requires decisive cleansing, or when your magic must begin on undisturbed ground.
