Spellwork Applications

- **Warding Bundles:** Hung at doors or windows to keep harmful forces at bay.
- **Banishing Rites:** Added to jars, powders, or fire spells to drive out unwanted energies.
- **Circle Protection:** Scattered around ritual spaces to reinforce boundaries.
- **Inner Strength Work:** Carried to bolster courage and spiritual resilience.
- **Tool Cleansing:** Placed near ritual implements to dispel lingering residue.

Blessed Thistle is an herb of sharp mercy. It does not soothe; it clears. It does not comfort; it defends. Call upon it when you need your magic to stand firm, when your space must be made clean, or when your spirit requires a spine of iron. Treat it with respect — its thorns remember every boundary they have ever protected.
