- **Bright Perception:** Sharpens intuition, insight, and emotional clarity.
- **Gentle Protection:** Creates a warm, ember-like ward that repels subtle negativity.

Spellwork Applications

- **Purification Rites:** Burned or scattered to cleanse rooms, tools, or ritual boundaries.
- **Ancestral Offerings:** Added to altars or jars to honor lineage and invite guidance.
- **Clarity Work:** Used in blends that require insight, decisiveness, or emotional illumination.
- **Warm Wards:** Incorporated into protective charms that rely on steady, gentle fire.
- **Divination Preparation:** Placed near tools to brighten intuitive pathways and clear interference.

Notes for the Practitioner

Sumac is a herb of ember-wisdom. It does not blaze; it glows. It does not scorch; it clears. Call upon it when your spirit needs warm illumination, when your space requires gentle purification, or when your magic must be guided by the quiet fire of those who came before you.
