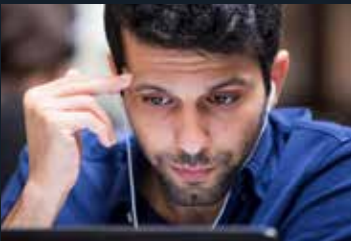

INNOVATIVE CURRICULUM

- 1L Students join faculty-mentored teams to assist real clients and begin honing essential skills in legal writing, leadership, experiential learning, advocacy and professionalism.

- 3L Theory, coursework, and practice experience come together in the capstone: four to eight months of intensive legal work in an externship setting or an in-house clinic.
