Rent for Fellowship hall (mystery \$650 and holiday party \$500) use has gone up to \$1,150. for two days. We need to find another more affordable location. Or come up with plan B. The board agreed to not raise class prices at this time, to stay competitive.

A motion to close the meeting was submitted by Rose and seconded by Lucinda. Meeting was adjourned at 10:33 am.
