Composition Festival 2025 Submission Instructions for Students

- 1. With your teacher, print, fill out, and sign the entry form on the previous page. Have your teacher mail your entry form with payment as stated above.
- 2. Finalize your composition using your composing software program and prepare it for submission. Format it like this:
 - Margins must be one inch all around the document top, bottom, left, right.
 - Center composition title use 24 point Times New Roman font.
 - Add your name and age upper right corner under title use 10 point Times New Roman font.
 - Please put a copyright symbol, the year 2025, and your name at the bottom of each page of the score.
 - Include page numbers if more than one page.
 - Save your composition as a PDF file.
 - DO NOT put your teacher's name anywhere on your score or audio file.
 - Scores that do not follow this format will be returned for corrections.
- 3. Record your composition and save it as a MP3 or MP4 file. Or, export a recording of your composition from your composing program as a MP3 or MP4. An MP3 or MP4 file is required for your composition to be adjudicated.

In the body of the email, put:

- ✓ Composition title
- ✓ Attach both the PDF file of your score **AND** your MP3 or MP4 file.
