Composition Festival 2026 Submission Instructions for Students

1. With your teacher, print, fill out, and sign the entry form on the previous page. Have your teacher mail your entry form with payment as stated above.
2. Finalize your composition using your composing software program and prepare it for submission. Format it like this:
 - Margins must be one inch all around the document – top, bottom, left, right.
 - Center composition title - use 24 point Times New Roman font.
 - Add your name and age - upper right corner under title - use 10 point Times New Roman font.
 - Add measure numbers at the beginning of each system.
 - Please put a copyright symbol, the year 2026, and your name at the bottom of each page of the score.
 - Include page numbers if more than one page.
 - Save your composition as a PDF file.
 - **DO NOT put your teacher's name anywhere on your score or audio file.**
 - Scores that do not follow this format will be returned for corrections.
3. Record your composition and save it as a MP3 or MP4 file. Or, export a recording of your composition from your composing program as a MP3 or MP4. A MP3 or MP4 file is required for your composition to be adjudicated.
