Composition Festival Entry Instructions

Registration Deadline: April 2, 2027 by midnight

Composition Festival 2027 Submission Instructions for Teachers:

1. **To register students:** Log in to your Teacher Dashboard in Regista, find the Tualatin Valley District Composition Festival event, then follow instructions on Regista to enter registrations. Payment is only through Regista with PayPal. Payment for all student entries must be completed at the same time, and by midnight on April 2, 2027.
2. The application fee is \$30 per student and does not include a copy of the Composition Book. Copies of the TVOMTA Composition Book containing the entries from 2027 may be purchased for \$7 each.
3. **Send your student(s) scores and audio files by email** to abbyteachespiano@gmail.com with the email subject: **Composition Festival 2027 Submission**

In the body of the email, put:

- ✓ Student's first and last name
- ✓ Composition title
- ✓ Attach both the PDF file of your score **AND** your MP3 or MP4 file.

4. Please send a separate email for each student entry.

Student Composition Instructions:

Finalize your composition using a composing software program and prepare it for submission.

Format it like this:

- Margins must be one inch all around the document – top, bottom, left, right.
- Center composition title - use 24 point Times New Roman font.
- Add your name and age - upper right corner under title - use 10 point Times New Roman font.
- Add measure numbers at the beginning of each system.
- Please put a copyright symbol, the year 2027, and your name at the bottom of each page of the score.

- Include page numbers if more than one page.
 - Save your composition as a PDF file.
 - **DO NOT put your teacher's name anywhere on your score or audio file.**
 - Scores that do not follow this format will be returned for corrections.
 - *Composition length maximum is 7 minutes.*
5. Record your composition and save it as an MP3 or MP4 file. Or, export a recording of your composition from your composing program as an MP3 or MP4. An MP3 or MP4 file is required for your composition to be adjudicated.
