#### 6. Regular Agenda

- a. Resolution No. 2023-03: Electronic Signatures Authorization
  - i. Resolution authorizing the use of electronic signatures for conduct of business
  - ii. The report was delivered by Ameer Othman.
    - 1. Overview of the critical elements of the resolution for the board's consideration:
      - a. The Authority's Board expressed a desire to establish standards for when e-signatures may replace hand-written or wet signatures on SSVBA docs, thereby encouraging the use of paperless e-docs when appropriate and allowed by law.
      - b. Through the collaborative efforts of MBEP (Executive Director) and Aleshire & Wynder, LLP (General Counsel), staff had prepared Resolution No. 2023-03 authorizing the use of electronic signatures and defining the appropriate conditions for its use for the board's conduct of business.
      - c. Electronic Signature is not required to be subject to a digital certificate issued by a licensed certificate authority to authenticate signed electronic documents unless otherwise noted. It may also include scanned, faxed, or emailed copies of signatures.
      - d. This resolution broadly permits the use of electronic signatures. Still, in some circumstances, electronic signatures cannot be used, or only electronic signatures with a digital certificate may be used. Those items were outlined in detail in the resolution to inform the public and the board where electronic signatures can and cannot be used.

e. The presentation was concluded with a recommendation to call for a motion to approve and adopt the resolution effective immediately.

A MOTION by LeBarre, seconded by White, to approve Resolution No.2023-03 to authorize the use of approved and outlined electronic signatures.

## b. National Telecommunication & Information Administration (NTIA) Presentation

- i. Overview of the Federal & State Broadband Funding in California
- ii. The report was delivered by Ameer Othman.
  - On behalf of Gladys Palpallatoc, Federal Program Officer/State Lead for the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA), MBEP staff provided an overview of the Existing Federal & State Broadband Funding in California & how the (Digital Equity Act & BEAD Broadband Funding Plans) will fit into this all.
  - 2. The briefing provided covering various broadband implementation programs across the state of California and its two essential leading offices tasked to bridge the digital divide (CPUC & CDT)
  - 3. Various broadband programs administered by the CPUC discussed included:
    - a. California Advanced Services Fund (CASF)
    - b. Federal Funding Account (FFA)
    - c. Local Agency Technical Assistance Program (LATA)
    - d. Loan Loss Reserve Program
    - e. BEAD Program
  - 4. Various broadband programs administered by the CDT discussed included:
    - a. Statewide Middle-Mile Broadband Initiative (MMBI)
    - b. Digital Equity Act Programs
  - 5. The report was concluded by sharing key California dates and timelines for both the state's BEAD and Digital Equity Plans.
  - 6. No action was recommended or included in this item. The presentation was simply for informational purposes.

- 1. The report aimed to update the board on the banking updates since the previous meeting on June 7, 2023.
  - a. Following direction from the board, MBEP staff successfully removed the former City Manager of Gonzales, Trevin Barber, as a signatory and added the new City Manager of Gonzales, Carmen Gil, to the JPA's Public Account.
  - b. MBEP staff updated the SSVBA's latest account balance, as of August 1, 2023, totaling \$125,000.
  - c. MBEP staff shared that the FY 2023-2024 invoicing will be sent out to the five JPA members in the coming days.
    - Per the original signed agreement forming the SSVBA, each of the four-member cities and the county of Monterey agreed to provide the necessary capital to initially fund the operations of the Authority during Fiscal Years 2022-2023, 2023-2024, and 2024-2025.
    - Members will be expected to contribute \$25,000 each to ensure the financial sustainability of the JPA moving forward.
  - d. No action was recommended or included in this item. The updates were to share the latest on the various banking and financing items for the board.
