- Atraumatic extraction of Mandibular 1st molar and Immediate wide diameter implant placement and bone graft
- Atraumatic extraction of Maxillary 1st molar and Immediate wide diameter implant placement with trans-alveolar osteotome sinus lift and bone graft
- A traumatic extraction of Maxillary Central Incisor with Immediate implant, immediate provisional abutment, immediate temporary, and socket bone graft (tooth in a day)
- Soft tissue uncovering (double "Z-plasty" papilla rebuilding) of implant with insertion of custom abutment/temporary
- Soft tissue uncovering of implant with palatal roll connective tissue graft
