# Ontario takes softball gold

Ontario won the Canada Summer Games women's softball championship for the first time, beating Alberta twice Saturday for the gold.

Ontario, which had lost to Alberta 3-1 in Friday's semifinal, won 5-0 and 6-2 before a sellout crowd of 2,016 at the Douglas J. Tarry Sports Complex in St. Thomas.

Women's softball was introduced at the 1985 Summer Games in Saint John, N.B.

Jessa Janelle, from Kitchener, pitched the first game.

Melissa Finley, from London, pitched the second game, carrying a shutout into the sixth inning.

"This is the best feeling I've ever had," said Finley, 19, who leaves in two weeks for Princeton University in Princeton, N.J. "Fifteen players trained hard for two years for this."

Ontario used a five-run fourth inning to win the second game, but almost didn't get to the final.

Ontario edged British Columbia 4-3 in the morning's bronze-medal game, rallying from a 3-0 deficit with a four-run fourth inning, capped by a bases-loaded, two-out triple by left-fielder Ruth Yzerman.

"We needed that big hit and Ruthie came through," said Ontario head coach Rick Finlay.

Friday, Ontario became the first host men's team to win the Games gold in softball. The men's game was in the first Summer Games in 1969 in Halifax/Dartmouth.
