Guests present were Frank Bowles, Gene Cohen, Jimmy Mayne, Bob Tone, & Jim Wilson. President zuHone mentioned that the club needed volunteers for the Car Corral at the January 27<sup>th</sup> Devereaux-Kaiser Car Show. Gene Cohen, Car Corral chairman, said he would contact volunteers for the show. Bob said he would contact show coordinators to get the location of the Car Corral and other pertinent show information.


