Salt Works is a custom shop in Sarasota that works on Hot Rods, Customs, & Metal Shaping. They have six employees. When they take in a vehicle they work on it until it's finished to the customers needs or work order. So, they don't start on a vehicle and push it off to the side.

The shop has two work areas, one for metal shaping & fabrication and the other section for mechanical work. They are a dealer for several companies such as Vintage Air; Roadsters Shop for frames (which can take up to six months because frame shops are so busy); American Autowire for

wiring harnesses; and Hotchkis for suspension parts. Once all fab work/body work is completed they take them by enclosed trailer to a PPG shop in Kokomo, IN. The outcome is fabulous as we saw in the dark blue 1950 Chevy! The shop is very clean, tools are all organized and they can do "one off services". So if you want louvers for your hood, fender skirts created, or CNC plasma cutting, they have the tools & knowledge to satisfy your needs. 

1918 Milburn Electric

One of the rarest and most interesting of the cars shown at 2019 Devereaux-Kaiser is this 1918 Milburn Electric. The Milburn Electric was built in Detroit from 1914 to 1923, when it was sold to General Electric. Powered by a 76 volt General Electric DC motor, the car was advertised with a top speed of 18mph, though owner Ron Milburn (no relation) of Sarasota claims that going downhill he can hit 21mph. What is more unusual is that this example is entirely original, with paint and upholstery that came from
