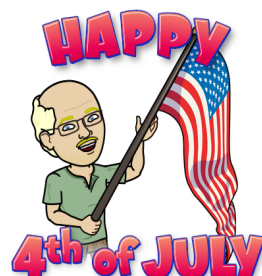

President zuHone welcomed Maggie Kruger, a guest of Mark Spears.

Secretary's Report – Joe Malaney: Jacki Kaiser made a motion to approve the May 29, 2019 Sunshine Region Minutes as published. Dick Brown seconded the motion. Motion was approved.

Treasurer's Report – Gerry Shapiro: Gerry listed the checking account and CD balances. Expenses for the month were \$154 for printing and mailing the *Stutter 'n Sputter*. Income was \$25 from dues. Linda Langenegger made a motion to approve the report. Gene Cohen seconded the motion. Motion was approved.

### Committee Reports

Sunshine – Joyce Tone: Ellen Cavanaugh is in her 5<sup>th</sup> round of Chemotherapy for her cancer. John Anderson is going through six weeks of radiation and chemotherapy for his cancer.

Newsletter – Jimmy Mayne: Jimmy brought a video projector and showed some photos of members cars. He explained the projector belonged to the Sunshine British Car Club but was on loan to our club. If the club thought it would be useful at meetings, we might consider purchasing a projector. Jimmy reviewed the April & May Mystery Photos. more information. Bob also talked about getting younger people involved in the car hobby and what clubs could do to increase their participation.

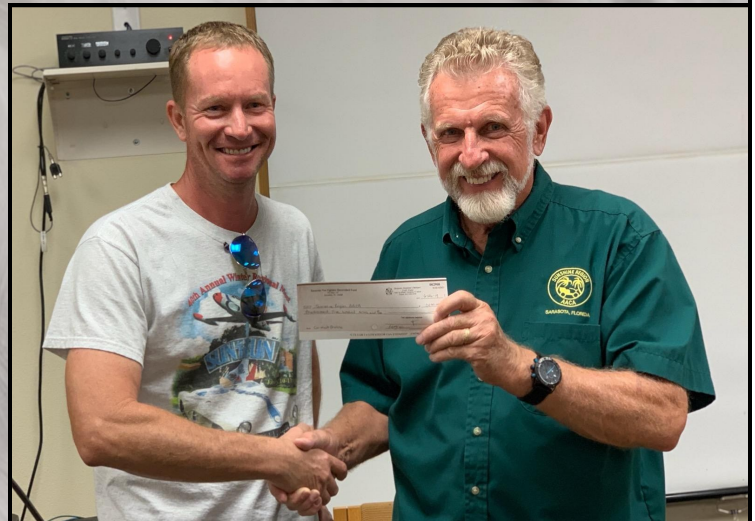

## Michigan Upper Peninsula Tour

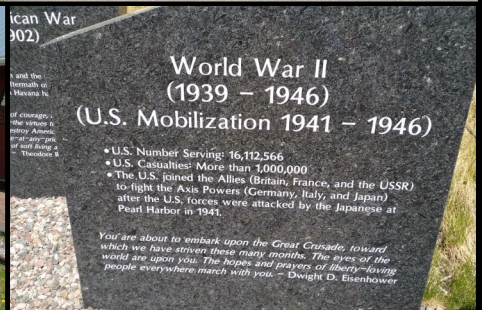
