



Secretary's Report – Joe Malaney: Jacki Kaiser made a motion to approve the May 29, 2019 Sunshine Region Minutes as published. Dick Brown seconded the motion. Motion was approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> – Gerry Shapiro: Gerry listed the checking account and CD balances. Expenses for the month were \$154 for printing and mailing the Stutter 'n Sputter. Income was \$25 from dues. Linda Langeneger made a motion to approve the report. Gene Cohen seconded the motion. Motion was approved.


more information. Bob also talked about getting younger people involved in the car hobby and what clubs could do to increase their participation.

This vast group of dozens of classics include Packard, Lincoln, Cadillac, Cord, Chrysler, Studebaker, Oakland, and Reo along with motorcycle brands such as Indian, Harley Davidson, Pope, BSA, Crocker, Ceccato racers, and Triumphs. He also has Porsche, Ferrari, Alfa Romeo, Shelby Cobra, and a GT-350 in race cars. Not to be excluded are several '32 Ford hot rods. The age of
