It was an uneventful trip to Tallahassee on November 4, 2019 for the two ladies. Upon arrival they checked into their two room suite for the 12th Henry Joy Packard Tour. However, this was the first Joy Tour for Jacki Kaiser, a member of the Florida Packard Club, and her guest, Linda Langeneger. The Tour was named in honor of Henry Bourne Joy (1864-1926), President of the Packard Motor Car Company who was also successful in getting the Lincoln Highway project completed, and was responsible for the development of the Liberty Motor airplane engine.

Day one of the tour found Jacki riding in the back seat of 1933 blue Packard sedan while Linda was navigator in a 1924 red and black Packard roadster. The group of 68 participants, riding in 25 Packards, visited St. Mark's lighthouse and enjoyed a sightseeing boat ride at Wakulla Springs.

On Tuesday the ladies rode in a 1934 green Packard club sedan. The day included an excellent tour of the Pebble Hill Plantation in Thomasville, Georgia, where all the furnishings were original and left behind by the family for posterity to enjoy! The day also included a visit to the Thomasville History Museum.

Wednesday found the ladies riding in an open car. Yes, the top was down! The weather was perfect for it, and the view of Tallahassee's famous canopy roads and blue skies was beautiful and relaxing from the back seat of a yellow and tan Packard sedan. What a gorgeous ride! 


Bruce Skaggs submitted this photo of his 1962 Triumph TR3 sporting its new AACA Mileage Award badge.




Barbara Brown tripping around in Bob ZuHone's 1949 Plymouth just like the one she drove in High School.
