Henry Pugh Property Tour: 02-Feb-2020

Sunday morning several Sunshine Region members met Henry Pugh, owner of Dynamic Motor Cars (a PPG collision shop on Palmer Rd). He is also a fellow Club member and advertiser in our monthly newsletter. Dynamic Motor Cars has been owned an operated by Henry and his wife Peggy since the early 80's with many of their techs having more than 34 years of experience. They are I-CAR Gold and spray PPG Envirobase waterborne paint which offers excellent color matching capabilities.

Our group's objective was to see what was on property near Myakka City that Henry had inherited from his dad. Over several years time, his dad had used this land for storage of salvage vehicles. Henry said that he is working with local officials to clean up the site. He said that there were over 200 vehicles that needed to be sold or otherwise disposed of.

The weather was great touring the 18 acres where we found many makes & models.

There was a lot more to be seen, including a late '50's Nash Rambler with a factory continental kit. We even found a Mack semi truck & trailer loaded with engines three rows high and two rows deep front to back. There was also a garage filled with body parts, wheels, hubcaps, trim, & engines parts.

Henry has already sold several vehicles and is working on securing titles for all the vehicles. He plans to clear the lot which he said will take at least a year.

## Sarasota National Cemetery: 18-Feb-2020

On the morning of Tuesday February 18th, more than a dozen of our members met at Sommer's Dutch Restaurant on Cattlemen Road to begin our journey. The Patterson Foundation contributed over \$14,000,000 to create an amphitheater for special occasions, usually for national holidays. We were met by an excellent tour guide who shared information regarding the various aspects of the cemetery. His knowledge of the place and so many back stories made the tour very interesting. One story was regarding Arlington National Cemetery and the land upon which it was built. It seems the land was the property of Robert E. Lee, and the acquisition took place during the Civil War. Very interesting history lesson. The permanently mounted photos depicting various events surrounding war time were very moving. We then motored back to Sommer's for a nice lunch. The ensuing conversations indicated that those in attendance found the tour to be much more interesting & informative than had been expected.
