




# Gene Cohen's 1936 Packard Project Update

Status as of 14-Jul-2020:

- 1. Body mounted in final position and door gaps set
- 2. Body & sheet metal parts in primer and nearly ready for application of skin coat, block sanding, & paint
- 3. Rumble seat lid acquired and ready to fit
- 4. Interior floor nearly done
- 5. Seat springs rebuilt and ready for upholstery




