



# Independence Day Parade: Sarasota, FL

#### **President's Corner**

There was a most interesting newspaper article regarding a lasting legacy in Sarasota having to do with Arnold Berns, "Historical Activist". This article appeared in the paper the week of June 20th. Many of us in the AACA Sunshine Region knew Arnold going back to the 1970's. I had no idea of Arnold's involvement in the community. He helped start the Maurice Devereaux Car Show in 1970 in Whitfield Estates with six cars on his front lawn. My wife, Ellen, and I attended our first Devereaux Show in 1972, and it expanded to over 1000 cars with different Sarasota venues over the many years. Maurice Devereaux needed help, and Tom Kaiser gave his assistance. In 1980 it became the Devereaux-Kaiser show. In 1990, our AACA Sunshine Region took over responsibility for conducting the show. In June 2018 a contract was signed between our Club and the Sarasota County Firefighter's Benevolent Fund to transfer primary ownership of the show to that group, Arnold's Studio 41 was created in the 1970's. The house was built in 1952. It was the home that Ted Wilson lived in as a young boy when Highway 41 was a two lane road. Ted had mentioned to me that his Dad had a sign for those driving South, that the Wilson gas station was the last gas station until Venice. Ted Wilson is still an architect and contractor in Sarasota. Another interesting commentary was that Arnold also owned the Bispham house next door where Cy Bispham was raised. Cy was in my Rotary Bay Club of Sarasota for many years. He was one of the founding members of the Sarasota Rotary Club in 1958. The last monthly AACA car club meeting that Arnold attended was this past March.
