

#### Nate's Honor Animal Rescue Tour: 18-Jan-2022



On a very chilly Tuesday morning, 22 club members drove the scenic Lorraine Road to Nate's Honor Animal Rescue in Bradenton. We were greeted by the very personable Director, Rob Oglesby, who guided us through this fabulous facility.

In 2008 Rob, his wife, daughter, and a small group of volunteers had a dream to save the lives of homeless and at-risk animals. The late Nathan (Nate) Benderson donated the eight acres of land. An anonymous donor (guess who) gifted five million dollars toward their dream.

This is a non-profit 501C, no-kill shelter and adoption facility. It houses a 20,000 sq ft welcome & adoption center, eight Katrina cottages, veterinary care center, cat habitats, walking trails, training center, intake & spa treatment rooms, and a bone shaped pool. Ten years and 10,000 adoptions later, their daily challenge of saving the lives of homeless animals is greater than ever. Our club made a donation of \$100 and several members gave extra. We were able to interact with a few of our furry friends waiting to be adopted.


We need a new secretary (volunteer) to fill Joan's position. Linda had to fill Joan's duties and we promised Linda double no pay.




