The Duesenberg is a real production car that was made by Duesenberg Motor Car Company of Gardena, California. They had saved the rights from the original Auburn Cord Duesenberg Company when it had closed in the 1930's. The company opened up again under the name of Duesenberg Motors. They made less than a dozen cars from 1971-1974 before going out of business. Gene Cohen's Duesenberg is a copy of the SS Speedster that the original Duesenberg Company built for Gary

Cooper and Clark Gable. The front view of the car is a faithful copy of the original. The fenders and the lights are the same distance as the original, as referenced from parts left over from the 1930's. Gene's Duesenberg has a 400hp Chevrolet motor.

several years. We are both pretty excited. Enough said, stay tuned


