

RESCUE PLAN

- Competing teams leave the event location (Confederation Park)
 between 7 and 730am, returning to same location between 3 and
 330pm. Attendance is taken both in the morning and upon return to
 ensure all competitors are accounted for. If any team does not return at
 required time The Tournament director will contact them via cell phone.
 If no response from the team a search will be initiated and emergency
 services contacted
- For all on the water emergencies Competitors are to reach shore safely
 first, if they can, at which time they will notify the tournament director of
 their situation and where they are located. If competitors are unable to
 reach shore, they are to use their on-board emergency equipment to
 signal for help and call for emergency help; coast guard and 911
- While on shore, the tournament Director is acting First Aid responder during event hours, emergency services will be contacted and/or person in distress will be taken to Kingston General Hospital if deemed safe to transport
