## THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE

### "HE IS RISEN"

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has Risen! Remember how He told you, while He was still with you in Galilee: The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again!" Then they remembered His words. Luke 24:1-8 N.I.V.

Like the women who went to the tomb of Jesus, sometimes we seem to forget that we worship a Victorious Risen Savior. The women forgot the promise of Jesus regarding His victory over sin, death, and the power of darkness. As a result of their doubting they were in a state of mourning and depression instead of joy.

Often when we find ourselves in the middle of an unpleasant situation, wouldn't it be good to remind ourselves that we are Children of the Light? Wouldn't it be better to have implanted in our hearts those victorious words of faith "He is Risen!"

As we enter this Easter Season here at Jacob's Church, may we carry with us that message which transforms broken lives into lives of wholeness and newness. Jesus Christ is Risen! Jesus Christ has conquered Sin! Jesus Christ has conquered Death! Jesus Christ has conquered the Powers of Darkness!

With this message alive and real in our hearts, may God give us the vision to be "The Church on a Hill, Shining Forth for Jesus Christ."





Ebeling received her Pennsylvania license in funeral directing in June 2018 and will be working in a partnership with her father, Robert S. Nester, at their family's funeral home.


She earned her Bachelor's degree in physiological psychology in 2000 from Arcadia University, Glenside, Montgomery County.






A Northwestern Boys Basketball Team held practices Thursday, March 7, 14 and 21, 8:00-9:00pm.
