THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE "GIFTS FOR A KING"

Jesus was born in the town of Bethlehem, in Judea, during the reign of King Herod. At about that time, some astrologers from Eastern lands arrived in Jerusalem asking, "Where is the newborn King of the Jews? For we have seen his star in far-off Eastern lands, and have come to worship him." Entering the house where the baby and, Mary his mother, were they threw themselves down before him in worship. Then, they opened their presents and gave him gold, frankincense and myrrh. When they returned to their own land, they didn't go through Jerusalem to report to Herold, because God had warned them in a dream to go home another way. Matthew 2:1-2, 11-12 L.B.

As the old Bing Crosby song says, "It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas, everywhere I go." Having just celebrated Thanksgiving, we now have less than four weeks before we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ.

As we read the Christmas Story as recorded in the Gospel of St. Matthew, we once again are reminded of the three gifts presented to baby Jesus. These gifts are very important not only in material terms, but also in their spiritual/symbolic nature. The first gift was that of **gold**. This, the most precious of all metals, is a gift worthy of presenting to a King. This symbolizes that Jesus Christ is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. The Bible teaches in Revelation 19:15 that someday he will return to earth as a victorious King who will rule with a rod of iron. Jesus is not coming back as a meek baby to die again, but as a victorious **KING**!

The second gift was <u>frankincense</u> which is an incense used by priests. This gift symbolizes the fact that Jesus Christ is the one true High Priest of both Heaven and Earth. (Hebrews 7:22-28)

The third gift was <u>myrrh</u> which is an incense or perfume used to anoint a dead body. This gift symbolizes that Jesus Christ was going to die for the sins of mankind and is the only Savior of the world. (Romans 5:6, Romans 6:23, II Corinthians 5:21, Ephesians 2:13, Hebrews 9:12-14, I John 2:1)

Three gifts were given to the baby Jesus by the Wise Men. Each gift symbolizes something about the nature and ministry of Jesus Christ.

In the midst of all the hustle and bustle this time of the year don't forget that Jesus is the "reason for the season." Keep Christ in Christmas!



1. I'm not qualified ...

Qualifications: caring person, willing to learn, grow, and serve. God is the Cure Giver; you are the Care Giver.

2. I don't know what to say or do in a ministry situation...

Stephen Ministry training is thorough & practical & prepares you for whatever you may encounter. Sometimes you will just listen. And, God provides us with His words through the Holy Spirit.

3. I have problems in my own life! How can I help others with their problems...

A Stephen Minister's job is to walk beside another person as that person works through his or her struggles. You aren't the problem solver, but you bring stability, prayer, and Christ's love to the situation. God's help in your struggles is some of the best preparation you'll ever receive for caring for others during their tough times.

4. I don't have enough time to be a Stephen Minister...

This is true for almost everyone — time is a precious commodity. So precious, as a matter of fact, that it makes sense to use it on activities that make a real difference — in others' lives as well as our own. When you make the commitment to be a Stephen Minister, you will find the hours you need to devote to it. The Ministry becomes a priority among the many activities you're involved in. God always provides the time for Kingdom building.

Stephen Ministry Matches Super Bowl Experience

"Before I retired from coaching, my team was in the Super Bowl six times. I thought nothing would ever match that. But being a Stephen Minister has also been one of the greatest experiences in my life," says Bill Arnsparger, who coached for 23 seasons in the NFL. His last stop was as defensive coordinator for the San Diego Chargers. After he retired from coaching in 1994, he trained to become a Stephen

Minister at Torrey Pines Christian Church in La Jolla, California.

During his coaching career, Arnsparger heard about Stephen Ministry several times. "I knew it was important, so I waited until the right time in my life to get involved," Arnsparger says. "The hours I've invested in Stephen Ministry have brought me closer to the Lord and to others in my congregation.

"I find serving as a Stephen Minister very rewarding. It's an opportunity to work with people and really help them. Each care receiver inspires me to build my faith. I always benefit from our time together.



Bill Arnsparger spent 23 seasons as an NFL coach, with stops in Baltimore, Miami, New York, and San Diego. He then became a Stephen Minister at Torrey Pines Christian Church in La Jolla, California.

"I've learned that I can't always predict and plan what each visit will be like. I work to be open to new developments, and I hang in there when new problems come up. I know I can't just write a prescription to make my care receiver feel better. My job is to listen and to care. God takes care of the rest."

Asked about similarities between Stephen Ministry and football, Coach Arnsparger says, "Stephen Minis-

try builds confidence, both in the Stephen Ministers and in the care receivers. Stephen Ministry takes teamwork; in supervision we need to work together to provide the best care possible—to our care receivers and to one another. Each opportunity to care is a new challenge, a new experience, just as each game is."

Men sometimes wonder if Stephen Ministry is right for them. Coach Arnsparger shows that following Jesus in giving and receiving care is truly a "sport for real men."
