THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE "MEETING NEW CHALLENGES IN 2019"

Then the Lord told him, "Now I am going to send you to Pharaoh, to demand that he let you lead my people out of Egypt." "But, I'm not the person for a job like that! Moses exclaimed. Then God told him, "I will certainly be with you, and this is the proof that I am the one who is sending you; When you have led the people out of Egypt, you shall worship God here upon this mountain!" Exodus 3:10-12 L.B.

I'm sure we have all seen the Navy Promotional Poster which states, "It's Not Just A Job, It's An Adventure!" Life indeed is an adventure for those willing to face the challenges which present themselves. Some people thrive on meeting new challenges and the opportunity to learn. Others, however, are fearful of being in a new situation and the challenge which follow. Like Moses who was chosen to lead the Israelites out of the cruel bondage of Egypt we exclaim, "But I'm not the person for a job like that!"

I'm convinced that the greatest reason people fear a new challenge is because they lose perspective and get overwhelmed. Even though God promised to be with Moses, he was overwhelmed at the very thought of speaking to Pharaoh. Perhaps right now you are afraid of a new challenge which has come your way. If that is the situation you find yourself in, try to get the problem in perspective. For example, Moses could have said, "Well Pharaoh is strong and powerful, but my God is stronger than him." When faced with a new situation, which at first seems almost impossible to handle, I commit the problem to prayer. With a new strength and determination, I then begin to tackle the problem. So often I discover that the fears I had were not gigantic, but were really quite small.

With hard work, and faith in God we do not have to fear the new challenges which come our way. Remember, "we have nothing to fear, but fear itself," With the vision God has given us at Jacob's Church of being "The Church on A Hill, Shining Forth for Jesus Christ, "we cannot afford to let fear or anything else stand in our way of sharing the saving love of Jesus Christ with others. I promise all of you that God will challenge us in 2019 to be a faithful church worthy of bearing the name of His Son. With the same faith as the Apostle Paul who stated in Philippians 4:12 "I can do all things through Christ Jesus who strengthens me," may we be equal to the new challenges of 2019.




