THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE "OVERCOMING TEMPTATION"

And Achan answered Joshua, and said, "Indeed I have sinned against the Lord God of Israel, and thus and thus have I done: When **I saw** among the spoils a goodly Babylonish garment, and two hundred shekels of silver and a wedge of gold of fifty shekels weight, then **I coveted** them, and **took** them." Joshua 7:20,21

We have all heard the old expression "There are two things in life a person cannot avoid: Death and Taxes." I would like to add temptation as a third aspect of life which cannot be avoided. We read in the book of Joshua, about the man Achan who fell victim to temptation and the terrible consequences which followed. Achan kept for himself booty (wealth) from the battle which was fought. This temptation to "get rich quick" was against God's will for his people.

Jesus Christ himself could not avoid temptation. (Matthew 4:1-11) but the Bible also states that while Jesus was tempted, he was without sin. (Hebrews 4:15) This shows us that while it **is natural** to be tempted, it also **is possible** to overcome the temptation.

As we can see from Achan's experience, there are three stages in the cycle of temptation. **First**, a person is exposed to the temptation. Achan says, "I saw the garments, gold and silver." Remember, there isn't anything wrong with this stage. It is natural to face temptation. **Secondly**, we desire to have for our own what we have seen. Achan said, "I coveted the garments, gold and silver.

It is at this stage that we must decide how we will deal with the temptation. So often we tend to act or speak before our brain is in gear. There are several questions we could ask ourselves when being tempted, such as, "Will I hurt myself or someone else if I take, or do this? Another question we might stop to ask is, "Would God approve of this action?"

The way we respond to this second stage in the cycle of temptation will determine the **final stage**. The Bible is clear that God knows and cares for each of us individually. The Bible also proclaims that God is faithful and will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we are able to endure, but with the temptation will allow a means of escape. (I Cor. 10:13). Jesus overcame his temptation in the wilderness by relying on the power of prayer and the Word of God. This same power is available to us today along with the support that others in the church can provide.

Remember, this year, that whatever temptation you are facing whether it be drugs, over-eating or anything else, there are people here at Jacob's to help you. I hope that you will discover a victorious life in overcoming temptation. Unlike poor Achan who paid dearly for his weakness, Joshua 7:25, 26, may your life be a blessing to God and others.


Two AED (Automated External Defibrillator) Systems were purchased. One was placed in the church parlor area and one was placed in the Activity Center. The money was taken from the Jacob's Church Memorial Funds. An AED is a portable electronic device that automatically diagnoses the life-threatening cardiac arrhythmias of ventricular fibrillation and pulseless ventricular tachycardia, and is able to treat them through defibrillation, the application of electricity which stops the arrhythmia, allowing the heart to reestablish an effective rhythm.


