MOMENT!



What do you hope for your neighborhood?

Jefferson's exhibit at the DesignPhiladelphia festival asked citizens what they loved and what they hoped would be true about our city. Answers were displayed on a screen. Looking at the various responses, there was little difference between those of diverse beliefs and world views. For the large, intractable problems of our city, we all want the same thing. Whoever gets the credit for making a measurable change, whether that is Islam, Christianity, a policy, or people group, will earn the right to be heard among our city. That is one reason we look for Christ's Church to collectively address opioid addiction and the educational needs of our youth.

There are many churches and Christian nonprofits doing amazing work with those with **opioid addiction**. Unfortunately, churches outside Kensington often do not know how they and their members can get involved. Earlier this week, I (Dave) brought together faith leaders across the city to help shape an event where the regional Church can understand and learn how to get involved. Topics they would like to highlight are the science of addiction, understanding trauma, how this needs to be seen as a regional issue, and repentance about how differently we treated the crack epidemic. After presentations, they suggested the event feature discussions in small groups of people we don't already know and tables for non-profits to onboard new volunteers.

As for education, I assist the Philadelphia Gospel Movement to encourage church/school partnership and to develop a mechanism for sharing best practices. In order to develop a church school partnership, we believe 2 activities can nudge churches to that destination:

- · Prayer walks at a local school
- Learning about the school from the principal or volunteer coordinator, and asking how their church could serve

To encourage Christians and churches to adopt these steps towards a partnership, I created the site www.EveryPhilly.School. It's just the beginning, but am excited about the connections and resource sharing that this portal could become.
