#### THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE "OUR CHRISTIAN EXAMPLE"

"Don't tell lies to each other, it was your old life with all its wickedness that did that sort of thing, now it is dead and gone. You are living a brand-new kind of life that is continually learning more and more of what is right, and trying constantly to be more and more like Christ who created this new life within you. In this new life one's nationality or race or education or social position is unimportant, such things mean nothing. Whether a person has Christ is what matters, and he is equally available to all. Since you have been chosen by God who has given you this new kind of life, and because of his deep love and concern for you, you should practice tenderhearted mercy and kindness to others. Don't worry about making a good impression on them but be ready to suffer quietly and patiently. Be gentle and ready to forgive; never hold grudges. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Colossians 3:9-13 L.B.

I don't know if I'm imagining things, but it seems to me that the world is getting hard. More people seem less ready to volunteer their time or to "cut a break" to another person who is in need. I guess that these attitudes always existed, but I really do sense that they are more prevalent today in our American culture then in the recent past.

Even as God's People we are often tempted to accept this "Dog Eat Dog" philosophy. However, we must never lose sight of the fact that Jesus called us the Salt of the Earth. As Colossians 3:10 states, we must "try constantly to be more like Christ."

We must never accept the world's standards of behavior as our own. The world is watching how Christians live. Our Christian example is crucial in sharing the love of Christ in a sin sick world. We must strive to be honest, merciful, kind, forgiving, loving and thankful. In living this way, we are demonstrating that Jesus Christ is able to change people into something beautiful.

Of course, all of this takes a large amount of risk. Just as Jesus Christ was willing to die on the cross as the payment for our sins, we also must be willing to risk helping others. Only in surrendering all to Jesus Christ will we find true peace and fulfillment.

In one of my sermons over the past three weeks, I mentioned that we should not "waste" this "time," as we adjust to the challenges of the Corona Virus. It's difficult to reach out to others while at the same time keep our "Social Distancing." We might begin to feel sorry for ourselves and become bitter. Instead, why not use this opportunity to reach out to someone with the Love of Jesus Christ?! There's no better time than now to use our cell phones to reach out with concern and compassion. Why not ask God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit), who would you like for me to contact during this time?







The Northwestern Lehigh Veterans Memorial is continuing to move towards the construction phase in Ontelaunee Park. The attached architect's rendering shows the latest design for the memorial.

The essential piece needed to complete the design is the number of names that will be engraved on the granite panels so that the size of the memorial footprint can be determined. Our area churches are the most important source for veteran's names from your archives, memorials and cemeteries.

To date, 1725 names of Veterans have been entered in our data base. <u>The committee</u> has set July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 as the deadline for accepting names for engraving on the granite panels. Veteran's names will be engraved, in alphabetical order, on the panel that shows the time period in which they served.

Names received after July 4<sup>th</sup> may be added after construction is complete. Unfortunately, they will have to be placed where space is available on the panels which, will detract from the alphabetical order and make it more difficult to locate the Veteran's name.

An important consideration for the memorial design is the ability to add names of future veterans thereby including our youth who will answer the call to serve in future conflicts. In doing so, this memorial will perpetually honor the service of all our veterans from the birth of our Nation into the future, recognizing the on-going struggle to protect our individual and religious freedoms.

Our website, http://nwlehighvetsmemorial.org. shows the design and progress toward securing donations required to build the memorial. The symbolism of all the features designed into the memorial is explained. The website lists the names of all veterans that have been submitted to date, the Rules for Engraving and application form to submit Veteran's names. There is NO FEE to submit a Veteran's name to be included on the memorial before construction begins.

All activities scheduled for the month of April were cancelled due to the Coronavirus.


Home School Co-op will tentatively restart their school sessions in September.
