THE PASTOR'S EPISTLE Saying Goodbye Is Seldom Easy

"When Paul had finished speaking, he knelt down with all of them and prayed. They all wept as they embraced him and kissed him. What grieved them most was his statement that they would never see his face again. Then they accompanied him to the ship."

(Acts 20: 36-38)

The Apostle Paul first visited the city of Ephesus on his second missionary journey (Acts 18:19). Paul spent much more time in Ephesus on his third missionary journey, building up the church of Jesus Christ. As he was giving an account to the Ephesian elders (Acts 20: 17-35), he ended his teaching with the statement that he would never see his beloved Ephesians again. (Acts 20: 36-38) How sad it was for Paul to say goodbye! It is sad for Donna and me to say goodbye, too, to our beloved Jacob's Church family. But unlike Paul, we do have hope and plans to see you all again throughout our remaining years! We can only add, "God willing..."

I have so many precious memories from my 44 years of Christian ministry, 33 of which were at Jacob's Church.

I spent eight years at St. John's UCC in Fredericksburg, Pennsylvania and three years as a U.S. Navy chaplain at the Marine Corps Logistics Base in Albany, Georgia, before moving here to the beautiful northwestern Lehigh County.

This area certainly has been and will continue to be "home" for our family.

Think of all the precious memories we have shared over the past 33 years! Since the formation of Jacob's Church in 1761, I have the third longest ministry on the Reformed side of the Jacksonville Union Church.

As a parting word to my dear friends, I would like to leave you with the full assurance that you are in good hands with our faithful lay-leadership, as well as the guidance of the Evangelical Association and the Evangelical Congregation denomination.

Be assured that a faithful Bible-believer, who is doctrinally sound, will fill the pulpit.

Please be respectful, patient, and kind to the newly-elected pastor, whomever that person might be.

Several years ago, I wrote the following newsletter article. I am re-publishing this as my parting words for you!

The Most Important Message I Can Give

"For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

There are many areas of our lives which will change in the years ahead, and there are many important topics that could be addressed (marriage-enrichment, child-rearing, personal relationships, managing finances, etc.).

But I just want to share this simple, yet profound, Gospel Message:

If you've never fully accepted Jesus Christ into your heart as your personal Lord and Savior, do it now!

In order to help you make this most important decision, I have listed the following segments of Holy Scripture and a simple prayer of commitment:

John 10:10 (Christ speaking) "I came that they might have life and might have it abundantly." (Jesus wants your life to be full and meaningful!)

Romans 3:23 "For all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God."

Romans 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death." (i.e., spiritual separation from God)

Romans 5:8 "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

I Corinthians 15: 3-6 "Christ died for our sins... He was buried... He was raised on the third day, according to the Scriptures... He appeared to Peter, then to the twelve. After that He appeared to more than five hundred..."

John 14:6 "Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me." Acts 4:12 "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." John 1:12 "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God,

even to those who believe in His name."

Ephesians 2:8,9 "For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, that no one should boast.'

Read John 3:1-15 When we receive Christ, we experience a new birth! Revelation 3:20 (Christ speaking) "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him."

I John 5:11-13 "And the witness is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has the life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have the life. These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, in order that you may know that you have eternal life."

Prayer of Commitment



- 20. A motion to adjourn the meeting by Jared Hermany and seconded by Jim Moyer. The motion carried.


