Dear Jacob's Church Family,

After much prayer and consideration, I informed the Church Board on Monday, June 7th, 2021, that effective Tuesday, August 31st, 2021, I will be resigning as pastor of Jacob's Church. I believe that all of us at Jacob's Church were aware that one day this day would come. With that being said, I believe some of us were still shocked and even maybe dismayed by the news. Still, change, after thirty-three years, at Jacob's Church was about to happen.

What would this change look like? Who would the next pastor be? Who would lead Jacob's Church into the uncertain future? These are just a few questions, I believe, that some of us probably asked ourselves after coming to grips with Pastor Shay's retirement.

However, Jacob's Church is not the first church to face such a change. 




