THE PASTOR EPISTLE

"Live with love for one another"

"Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart." -1 Peter 1:22

I read an article by a guy named Howard Snyder who addressed this topic. This is what he had to say:

The church today is suffering a fellowship crisis. ... In a world of big, impersonal institutions, the church often looks like just another big, impersonal institution. ... One seldom finds within the institutionalized church today that winsome intimacy among people where masks are dropped, honesty prevails, and that sense of communication and community beyond the human abounds — where there is literally the fellowship of and in the Holy Spirit.

When you hear this, your mind might go right away to mega churches. How it is hard to even be recognized by the ministry team because there is just too many people in mega churches. However, I believe that we even suffer with intimacy issues in churches like Jacob's. All too often we wear masks and put-up walls when we walk into church. Why? Why is it when people ask how we are doing we answer them by saying, "fine." When that is usually not the case. When, in all honesty, you are actually hurting inside. Wanting to be accepted. Wanting somebody to come alongside of you and show you love through concrete acts. Wanting not to be judged, but to be loved.

Now, I understand that we have ministry teams such as Stephen Ministry to do this here at Jacob's Church, which is great. However, this is a command for the whole church to do. Not just for a small group of people. This is what Peter was talking about when he wrote,

"Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth so that you have sincere love for each other, love one another deeply, from the heart."

You see, we have been purified from our sins through Jesus' redeeming works. So, we should show genuine love to our brothers and sisters in Christ. Concrete love that results in actions. Actions such as offering to bring them to church if they don't have a ride. Showing someone love by offering to do things around their house while they are sick. You could even just sit down with them and pray with them about the situation they are currently going through.

No matter what, we should show this love to others because Jesus first showed this genuine love to us.




