THE PASTOR EPISTLE “God is Immutable”

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. – Hebrews 13:8

To say that our God is immutable is to say that God never changes. He is always the same. Just like you can always count on the sun to rise in the east and to set in the west. God never differs from Himself. Scripture points this out in Malachi 3:6, **“For I am the Lord, I change not.”**

Meaning that God is not held to such standards as His creation. He cannot become better or worse as he is a holy God, which means he is perfect. How can you make something that is already perfect better? You can't. When it comes to God, no change is necessary. As God is the apex of perfection.

So, not only does his holiness never change, neither does his love, his justice, his mercy, his grace, as well as all the rest of his attributes. God always remains the same. So, what does this have to do with us?

Well, out of all the things we could say about God's immutability, the one thing that we can take comfort in is that God never changes in his dealing with his creation.

I believe A.W. Tozer said it best when he said, *“Whatever God felt about anything, He still feels. Whatever He thought about anyone, He still thinks. Whatever He approved, He still approves. Whatever He condemned, He still condemns.”* As Hebrews 13:8 reaffirms, **“Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”**

So, we can take comfort in knowing that what God's Word says still holds true today. That what God called a sin is still a sin. That it has not evolved as the world would want you to think. Instead, God's Word is truth and will remain that way yesterday, today, and forever.

The same is true about God's plans. God has a plan for each and every one of your lives. From young to old. When I was born again, and I heard this, the Holy Spirit brought a sense of purpose to my life. A sense that my life had meaning. The same is true for each of you. As God knows everything about you. As Psalm 139 declares this perfectly. We read:

“You have searched me, Lord, and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue you, Lord, know it completely. You hem me in behind and before, and you lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.”

This chapter then goes on to explain how God has known you since before you were born. Anything that God has ever felt about you, he still feels. He still loves you, and cares about you. He wants to be involved in your life and wants great things for you. The same is true for all of his children. As God never changes. As his plans for you are the same yesterday, today, and forever.

Finally, God's plan for our salvation never changes. As we can be reassured that if we put our faith in Jesus Christ alone, we are saved. As John 3:16 reassures us, **“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”**

So, if you find yourself currently going through some changes in life, know that God will always remain the same. He is trustworthy because He is who He reveals Himself to be through Scripture, and He will never change. So, if you currently find yourself struggling, put your faith in a God you can always trust

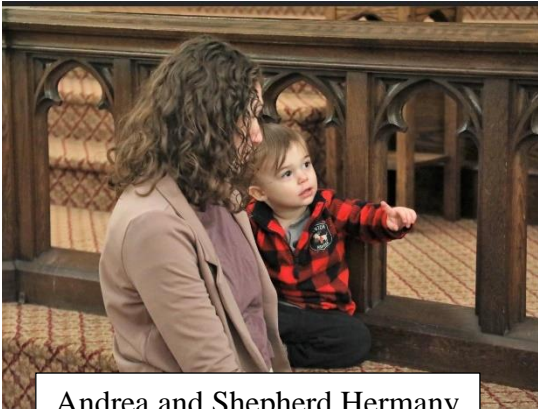

Panama Updates-Febrero 2023

Hello all my friends and supporters up north. I hope you all are doing fine and keeping warm. No problem keeping warm here. Hehehe

Yesterday, February 11, I celebrated 12 years here in Panama as a full time missionary. Of course I celebrated with ice cream.

Over the past 12, fantastic, years I have seen much change here. I have found myself so much busier than I expected with the ministry growing from 2 church services a month 8 years ago to 11 or 12 services per month now, plus movie nights- furthering the growth of faith through quality Christian movies with good messages. Some of the movies are great at showing how to put your faith in action. Add to all this, bible studies every Thursday night. It seems like a lot, but God has given me the strength and endurance and desire to do His will here in Panama.

In the last year I have come in contact with 18 orphans, without looking for them. Sad situations, but God raised up good caretakers for them. I help each family a bit as I can. Some of these kids are 'keepers'. I am blessed to be able to be a part of their lives.

The progress with the paperwork to get Eysbel to the USA has been excruciatingly slow. The health system here is broken. We'll move along with God's help, in His time. Eysbel is otherwise a very healthy, intelligent, adopted child of mine. Her and her sister call me dad.

We had great success with hands on praying on a friend in the church called, Sergio. He was having terrible problems with his epilepsy, having 3 attacks a week sometimes. We laid hands on him about 6 months ago and he has been free from attacks ever since. Thank you God. Now he has a full time job and is doing well. This is the second success story related to epilepsy attacks. And, he doesn't use any meds.

Having 5 churches has its challenges, but also its advantages. I can do the same sermons in most churches. When I develop a kid's activity, I can use it in all the churches. Fortunately, I have various people to sing in front of the congregations. Most are young and courageous. I am encouraging them to continue singing praises and participating in the services more.

The baby stroller that I shipped here is working out well for the invalid, Justin.

I'll be back in the states a week after Easter to spend 5 weeks there visiting family, friends and churches. This vacation I also plan on visiting the Arc in Kentucky.

A million thanks for each and every support donation that comes in. It all helps help do His work here in Panama.
