+ "From the Pastor's Study" **+**

You will be reading this in January, but I am writing it in December. That is a bit of a challenge. I am looking forward to Christmas. For you, Christmas 2023 has passed. You have unwrapped what was under the tree. My gifts are still in pretty paper and bows. You are back to weekly routines. I am still basking in the slowness of the season asking the LORD for everyone at Jacob's to catch a glimpse of God's glory made known to us through the birth of our Savior. I am praying your loved ones who seldom come to church will make it to our services on the 24th and be drawn to the wonder of the manger through our songs of joy and the proclamation of God's Word. I am asking the Holy Spirit to open their hearts to the joys of being reconciled to God through the love of Jesus Christ. I am praying for you that you will hear afresh the greatest story of all –the gospel so familiar to each of us–again with renewed amazement.

In January, you know how these prayers of mine were answered. I am still expectant. BUT... lying in a small crib in the back of their house so near to them was the Savior of the world. The One who spoke the universe into existence hadn't yet learned to say, "Daddy," and "Momma!" The God of the universe would soon be walking around their dwelling as a toddler. It is a bit overwhelming to think about. And I think you should welcome that sense of being overwhelmed. If you do, you might discover that somewhere in your house, or maybe better somewhere in your heart, dwells the Savior of the world and if you welcome His growing power and presence in your life your days will never look longingly back on Christmas, but they will be filled with the eternal joy of Christ's advent every day!
