Welcome to Christ Church Noida!




Romans 15:7 says, "Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God."

God Looks at Your Balance Sheet- both Financial & Spiritual

Finance management in a church is truly a God-given gift, one that calls for dedication, faith, and wise stewardship—especially in both prosperous and challenging times. Having devoted over twenty-one years to this sacred responsibility, it is humbling to reflect on how managing the church's finances is not just about numbers, but about trust in God's provision and generosity.

In times of plenty, it is easy to rejoice and see the fruits of faithful giving. The church flourishes, ministries expand, and hearts are lifted by the blessings God pours out. Yet, even then, wise management ensures that these blessings are used prudently and shared generously. The Old Testament offers timeless guidance, such as in Proverbs 3:9-10, where it is written, "Honour the Lord with your wealth and with the first fruits of all your produce; then your barns will be filled with plenty, and your vats will be bursting with wine." This reminds us that acknowledging God as the source of all abundance shapes responsible giving and stewardship.

When hardship strikes, financial stewardship within the church takes on a different, yet equally vital, role. Economic challenges or unexpected setbacks can test the patience and faith of the entire congregation. However, as Paul encourages in 2 Corinthians 8:12, "For if the readiness is there, it is acceptable according to what a person has, not according to what he does not have." During these times, prudent budgeting, thoughtful prioritising, and transparent communication with the congregation become essential. Each sacrificial gift, small or large, becomes the seed from which hope and renewal grow.

Looking back on these many years, the journey of managing church finances has been one of learning and grace. It is an ongoing dance between faith and responsibility, promises and practicalities. As Jesus reminds us in Luke 16:10, "One who is faithful in a very little is also faithful in much." Women's Retreat — Discipleship

The Women's Fellowship held an intra-church retreat on Discipleship. Mrs. Lydia Joshua addressed practical aspects of following Jesus and leading others to do the same. Key points from the message:

- Discipleship: Discipleship begins with personal commitment to Christ; only then can we effectively
 encourage others.
- **Obey:** The Holy Spirit dwells in every believer. We were asked to examine daily choices: are we cultivating the Spirit's work or feeding the sin that remains in us? (Clarifying question posed: Whom do we feed more?)
- Forgive: The Lord's Prayer was presented as the model for sincere repentance and forgiveness. Emphasis was placed on the word "as" our request for forgiveness is linked to our willingness to forgive others. Attendees were encouraged to pray the Lord's Prayer with renewed sincerity and to practice forgiveness in daily relationships.

Action points / follow-up:

- We should pray in groups for all those in need and for ourselves as well.
- Personal reflection prompts for members: examine habits that strengthen the Spirit; identify one relationship for intentional forgiveness or reconciliation.

On Sunday, Christ Church Noida gathered in joy and reverence as eleven young members of our congregation were confirmed by the Bishop of the Diocese of Delhi, Rt. Rev. Dr. Paul Swaroop. It was a sacred milestone for the candidates and a moment of reflection for the entire church family. In his sermon, Bishop Paul spoke on the theme "A New Heart, A New Start." Drawing from Ezekiel 36:26-28, he reminded us that Confirmation is far more than a ritual. It is God's promise of transformation—replacing a heart of stone with a heart of flesh, and filling believers with His Spirit to live renewed lives.

The Bishop emphasized three truths: a new heart and spirit that come from Christ, the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit who guides and strengthens us, and a new relationship with God that makes us His own people. With hands laid in prayer and blessing, each candidate affirmed their decision to follow Christ faithfully.

For the congregation, the service was not only about the candidates' step of faith, but also a call to remember our own journey of renewal. Confirmation Sunday became a reminder that we are all invited daily to live as God's transformed people—rooted in Christ, strengthened by His Spirit, and bearing witness to His Kingdom.
