



LIFE APPLICATION QUESTIONS
DEUTERONOMY CHAPTERS 1-34

Read Chapters 1-4. In Moses' final book, the focus is on recounting the great and mighty works of the Lord. Moses presents a series of reminder about what God has done and is doing for the Children of Israel. Moses presents a call to commitment and a focus on God's faithfulness. What mighty acts can you identify from your life in Christ? Please be specific.

Read Chapters 4-29. Before their entrance into Canaan, Moses reminds Israel that they are to distinguish themselves from other people/nations. Think about this today. How does God want us to distinguish ourselves, today? Please be specific in how you can be set apart in our world today because of your position in Christ.

God is the Divine authority of government, then and now. Spend time applying this Truth to your reaction to the world. How can you gain comfort from God's sovereignty?

“The Lord is the one who goes ahead of you; He will be with you. He will not fail you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed.” (Deut. 31:8). How and when can you apply this scripture to your life today?

Read Chapters 29-30. In 29:2 we read, “you have seen with your own eyes everything the Lord did . . .” What can you recount about what you have seen the Lord do in your own life?

In 30:1, Moses reminds the children “to take to heart all these instructions.” He also exhorts them in 30:16 to “love the Lord and obey His commandments.” How do these exhortations reveal themselves in your life, please be specific?

Read Chapters 31-34. Spend some time meditating on the song of Moses and write your reflections below.
