I pray that your love will overflow more and more and that you will keep on growing in knowledge and understanding for I want you to understand what really matters

Philippians 4:6

Don't worry about anything; instead pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank Him for all He has done

Colossians 3:16

Let the message about Christ in all its richness fill your lives.

1 Thessalonians 3:12

And may the Lord make your love for one another and for all the people grow and overflow

1 Thessalonians 5:11

So, encourage each other and build each other up

2 Thessalonians 1:11

May He give you the power to accomplish all the good things your faith prompts you to do

2 Thessalonians 3:5

May the Lord lead your hearts into a full understanding and expression of the love of God and the patient endurance that comes from Christ

1 Timothy 1:5

All believers would be filled with the love that comes from a pure heart and a clear conscience and genuine faith

2 Timothy 2:23b

A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone, be able to teach, and be patient with difficult people. Gently instruct those who oppose the truth.

2 Timothy 4:2b

Patiently correct, rebuke and encourage your people with good teaching

Hebrews 10:22

Let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting Him

Hebrews 10:23-24

Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep His promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works

Hebrews 10:36

Patient endurance is what you need now so that you will continue to do God's will

Hebrews 11:27b

Kept right on going because [he] kept his eyes on the one who is invisible

Hebrews 12:14-15

Work at living in peace with everyone and work at living a holy life . . . Look after each other . . . watch out that no poisonous root of bitterness grows up to trouble you

Hebrews 12:25

Be careful that you do not refuse to listen to the One who is speaking

Hebrews 13:9b

Your strength comes from God's grace

Hebrews 13:21

May he equip you with all you need for doing His will

1 Timothy 2:1

I urge you first of all pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them

2 Timothy 2:23

Don't get involved in foolish, ignorant arguments that only start fights

Hebrews 2:1

So, we must listen very carefully to the truth we have heard, or we may drift away from it

Hebrews 6:1b

Let us go on and become mature in our understanding

Hebrews 10:25

And let us not neglect our meeting together, but encourage one another

Hebrews 12:1b-2a

Let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus, the champion who initiates and perfects our faith.

Hebrews 12:12-13

So, take a new grip with your tired hands and strengthen your weak knees. Mark out a straight path for your feet so that those who are weak, and lame will not fall but become strong.

Hebrews 13:1-2

Keep on loving each other as brothers and sisters. Don't forget to show hospitality to strangers.

James 4:17

Remember it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it

James 5:9

Don't grumble about each other brothers and sisters or you will be judged

James 3:17

But the wisdom from above . . . shows no favoritism and is always sincere. And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness.

James 5:12

Just say a simple yes or no

James 4:7

So, humbles yourselves before God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Come close to God and God will come close to you.

1 Peter 1:16

You must be holy because I am holy.

1 Peter 1:17

And remember that the heavenly Father to whom you pray has no favorites.

1 Peter 1:22

Love each other deeply with all of your heart

1 Peter 3:8-9

Finally, all of you should be of one mind. Sympathize with each other. Love each other as brothers and sisters. Be tenderhearted and keep a humble attitude. Don't repay evil with evil. Don't retaliate with insults when people insult you. Instead pay them back with a blessing.

1 Peter 3:15

And if someone asks you about your Christian hope always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.

1 Peter 5:3

Lead them by your own good example

1 Peter 5:5

Serve each other in humility

1 John 3:18

Let us show the truth by our actions

James 5:16

Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results

1 Peter 1:14

So, you must live as God's obedient children

1 Peter 2:19

For God is pleased with you when you do what you know is right and patiently endure unfair treatment

1 Peter 4:10

God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another.

2 Peter 1:2

May God give you more and more grace and peace as you grow in your knowledge of God and Jesus our Lord.

2 Peter 1:3

By His divine power God has given us everything we need for living a godly life.

2 Peter 3:14

Make every effort to be found living peaceful lives that are pure and blameless in His sight

1 John 1:9

If anyone claims I am living in the light but hates a Christian brother or sister that person is still living in darkness

1 John 3:13

So don't be surprised dear brothers and sisters if the world hates you

1 John 4:1

Do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit. You must test them to see if the spirit they have comes from God.

Jude 1:3

Urging you to defend the faith that God entrusted once for all time to His holy people

Rev 17:17

For God has put a plan into their minds, a plan that will carry out His purposes

1 John 5:21

Dear children keep away from anything that might take God's place in your hearts

Revelation 3:19

I correct and discipline everyone I love. So be diligent and turn from your indifference

Revelation 19:10

Worship only God. For the essence of prophecy is to give a clear witness for Jesus.

1 John 4:16

We know how much God loves us and we have put our trust in His love

1 John 5:4
