Tell God what you need and thank Him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. 

A TESTIMONY TO CHRIST

Put on your new life and be renewed as you learn to know your Creator and become like Him (Colossians 3:8-10) Do not waste your time arguing over godless ideas and old wives' tales. Instead train yourselves to be godly (1 Timothy 4:7) A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone, be able to teach and be patient with difficult people. Gently instruct those who oppose the truth. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts and they will learn the truth. Then they will come to their senses and escape from the

devil's trap. For they have been held captive by him to do whatever he wants (2 Timothy 2:23-26). Are you falling into any of the enemies' traps? Clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Make allowance for each other's faults and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember the Lord forgave you so you must forgive others. (Colossians 3:12-13) Live wisely among those who are not believers and make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be gracious and attractive so that you will have the right response for everyone (Colossians 4:5-6). How are you clothing yourself in Christ? Be prepared whether the time is favorable or not (2 Timothy 4:2). How are your preparing yourself in service to the Lord? Brothers and sisters, we urge you to warn those who are lazy. Encourage those who are timid. Take tender care of those who are weak. Be patient with everyone. See that no one pays back evil with evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all

people. Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ
