Saturday 3 rd August 10:00 - Noon	Ramble from South Hill Park Joining a group that walks every Saturday (3.9 miles - also shorter cut-off) <i>With Jeff Lawrence</i> Start: South Hill Park Car Park, Bracknell, RG12 7PA
