### CLUE #2

#### OVERVIEW: WEDGE STAR BLOCKS & BLOCK BORDER

- Tools Needed <u>Wedge Star & Tucker Trimmer I\*</u>
- Techniques Wedge Star Octagon

For this clue; we will continue working with the Wedge Star Octagons, making them into a Block. You will use the Group 2 of your Jelly Roll Groups.

- Basic instructions are provided below. If you need additional information, refer to the instructions that came with the Wedge Star and Tucker Trimmer I

Clue #1	Clue #1 Wedge Star Octagons	25	NA	
A	HST Corner Triangle	100	Jelly Roll - Group 2 (Bright)	<ul> <li>(8) 2 ½" x WOF Strips;</li> <li>Sub cut each strip into (2) HWOF Strips (approximately 2½" x 20 ½").</li> <li>Label &amp; set aside one subset of Group 2 HWOF Strips for a later Clue.</li> <li>The other subset of Group 2 HWOF Strips: <ul> <li>Trim down into (8) 2 ¼" HWOF Strips.</li> <li>Then, sub cut (7) 2 ¼ Squares from (4) Strips and (6) 2 ¼ Squares from the other (4) Strips for total of (50) 2 ¼" Squares.</li> <li>Next, sub cut all (50) squares into half diagonally to create (100) HST.</li> </ul> </li> <li>With the Group 2 HWOF Scraps, cut the remnants into 2" Squares - You should be able to get (2) from the first 4 Strips and (3) from the second (4) Strips = Total (20) 2" Squares. Label as 2" Squares and set aside for a later clue</li> </ul>
В	Background Large Wedge	100	Background	<ul> <li>(9-10) 2" x WOF Strips</li> <li>Sub cut into (100) 2" x 3 ½" Rectangles.</li> <li>Set aside (50) 2" x 3 ½" Rectangles for a later Clue.</li> <li>Use the other (50) 2" x 3 ½" Rectangles for Step 6</li> </ul>



#### WEDGE STAR BLOCK & BLOCK BORDER

#### CONSTRUCTING THE WEDGE STAR BLOCK

- 1. Gather the (25) Wedge Star Octagons from Clue #1.
- 2. Mark halfway registration mark on all four Bright Large Wedges of each of the Wedge Star Octagons, to prepare them to have Corner Triangles attached. You can do this one of two ways:
  - a. Wedges can be folded in half matching the seams and then lightly pressed to give a centerfold line.
  - b. Or the centerline of the tool can be placed on the sewn seam with the point of the tool at the center. Mark with a removable marking tool. (My preference).
- 3. Place your Wedge Star® tool upside down, with the Invisigrip™ facing up. Using a ruler, measure down 1 ¾" distance from the flat edge of the tool and make a mark on the back of the tool, across the centerline as illustrated below.
- 4. On your cutting mat, place the intersection of the centerline of the tool and the Sharpie® marked line on the center of the sewn block. At the same time, align the centerline of the tool with the halfway registration mark on the fabric block.
- Cut along the flat edge of the tool. You should only be trimming off a small amount of fabric. Note: If you are trimming more than ¼", recheck your tool mark! Repeat for the other three Bright Large Wedges. Repeat for all (25) Wedge Octagons.
- 6. **Position** a HST Corner Triangle right sides together with a trimmed Wedge. Align the raw edges and make sure that it is roughly centered over the Wedge.
- 7. Stitch with the Wedge on top, stitch with a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam and press towards the Corner Triangle. Repeat until you have triangles on all four corners of all (25) units.







# TICKER TAPE PARADE

#### MINI-MYSTERY - JELLY ROLL CHALLENGE BY MICHELLE RENEE HIATT

Trim with the Tucker Trimmer I. Align the common diagonal and 3 ½" sizing diagonal with the marks made for the previous trimming. Make sure that the intersection of the tool lines is over the center. Trim two sides.
 Right Handed







9. Rotate the block 180° and line up the diagonal lines as well as the clean up lines with the trimmed edges. Trim the final two sides. Repeat for all (25) units.



10. Gather (50) background 2" x 3 ½" Rectangles. Position (25) Background Rectangles on left side and (25) Background Rectangles on the Right side of the trimmed Wedge Star unit.





- 11. Stitch togethe with your best 1/4" seam and press towards the Rectangles.
- 12. Label and set aside. You are now ready for the next Clue.
