PROFILE

I am a dynamic and dedicated educator with over a decade of national and international teaching along with tons of performance experience - combining creativity, curiosity, and skill-based activities to inspire learners of all backgrounds. My experiences in a variety of vastly different settings have refined my classroom management, adaptability, and communication skills.

I am a strong advocate for character education, social-emotional growth, and behavioral justice within the classroom. I have cultivated classroom environments where curiosity leads to confidence and learning sparks joy and comprehension. I've had quite the 'educational-entreprenuer' career as both a performer and teacher, designing engaging, interdisciplinary classes and shows that empower others to discover their unique abilities and connect what they are learning to the wider world around them.

I've found that language, like the arts or a skill-based activity like the yo-yo, is a bridge for connection —a way to celebrate diversity and foster belonging. I am passionate about speaking Spanish and have learned pieces of several different languages along my journey such as Thai and Chinese. I value building inclusive environments and one way I do that personally is to find a connection point, speak to them in their own language, literally or figuratively (such as connecting about a hobby or interest, or even their issue behind a problematic behavior:))

I have consistently focused on helping young people discover their unique gifts and see learning as both purposeful and fun. The yo-yo—one of my favorite teaching tools—serves as a tool and a toy: it demonstrates science, technology, resilience, effort, curiosity and awe. Students light up when they see that learning can be active, skill-based, and full of wonder.

Through my yo-yo practice and performance, I get to model skill development, focus, and resilience. I've created a program (yoyo magic dot fun) that utilizes creative strategies that engage multi-aged participants and sustain attention through engaged learning. The yo-yo demonstrates how consistent effort, curiosity, and reflection build mastery and confidence, which then can translate to all subjects.

My personal philosophy is the acronym **JOY**:

- **J stands for** *Joy***,** the result of effort and perseverance from learning to do something.
- O represents Openness—the willingness to try new things and grow from mistakes.
- **Y is** *You*—develop your abilities and you create joy for yourself, share your abilities and you create joy for others
