TOP FLIGHT GOLF CLUB OPERATING PROCEDURES

- 1. The club will play Winter Rules at all Tournaments, a 6" bump, no closer to the pin, is allowed in fairways and rough. You can not bump your ball in Bunkers or Penalty Areas.
- 2. The club will allow players to play with players of their choice, only if space is available in that foursome.
- 3. All members must pay by Check, mailed to the Treasurer or by using Chase Quick Pay, Popmoney or a Banks Bill Pay. No cash will be accepted.
- 4. All members must pay for a Tournament prior to the close of the Tournament, which will be 10 days before the Tournament. When the Tournament is full, a waiting list will be established by order of receipt. All Entries will be processed on a first come first serve basis.
- 5. All Officers/Board of Directors, past or present, will be allowed to play in any Tournament without regard to the close of the Tournament rules.
- 6. In addition to greens fees, a \$10 tournament fee will be assessed.
- 7. If a member must cancel and the Golf Course does not charge Top Flight Golf Club for their Green Fees, a credit will be issued for use in a future tournament. If a member does not cancel before the deadline, has not paid their Green Fees and the Golf Course charges Top Flight G. C., that member will still owe their Green Fees to Top Flight G. C.
- 8. The Club Champions, (Men & Women), and the Club Championship Flight Winners shall be determined using the following criteria:
 - a. The 5 lowest net scores from regular tournaments will be averaged & that average will make up 50% of the Club Championship score.
 - b. The net score from the one designated Club Championship Tournament will make up the other 50% of the Club Championship score.
 - c. Your Flight will be determined using the Flight you are in at the one designated Club Championship Tournament.
 - d. After determining the Men's and Woman's Club Champions, the Club Championship Flight Winners will be determined from the <u>remaining</u> qualifying members.

- 9. The procedure for determining the order Members will be picked for Raffle Prizes at the Christmas Banquet.
 - a. Members who have played in all Tournaments will be called up 1st.
 - b. Members with the next highest number of tournaments played will be drawn next.
 - c. This procedure will be followed until we get to the members who have played in 0 Tournaments.
 - d. After all Members have received one Raffle Prize, all tickets will be put into a pot and tickets will be drawn until all of the Raffle Prizes are gone.
- 10. Top Flight Golf Club will award \$250 to any Top Flight Member who gets a Hole-In-One during a Top Flight Golf Club Tournament.
